Our Lady of Medjugorje's Message Given to Marija Pavlovic-Lunett April 25, 2022

"Dear Children! I am looking at you and I see that you are lost. That is why I am calling all of you: return to God, return to prayer – and the Holy Spirit will fill you with His love which gives joy to the heart. Hope will grow in you, also for a better future, and you will become joyful witnesses of God's mercy in you and around you. Thank you for having responded to my call."

Commentary on the April 25, 2022 Message

"...If a man wishes to come after me, he must deny his very self, take up his cross and follow in my steps. Whoever would preserve his life will lose it; but whoever loses his life for my sake and the Gospel's will preserve it." (Mark 8:34-35)

Our Lady sees much clearer than we do! She sees society in this present age as LOST! Lost into self, lost in material things, lost in the earthly life of selfishness, idols, and error. Lost in a godless way of life!

The pandemic was a wake-up call. If nothing else, the Covid scourge in the world should have reminded us of our mortality. There is no life apart from God. There is no path but that of prayer. The world needs to pray and return to God. Mother Mary is here with us to spread her messages around the world. She wants to wake society up to these truths and she wants our help. The world needs to pray and return to God. Those who are lost need

to find themselves – discover their purpose which is to know, love, and serve God in this life and be happy with Him in paradise in the next life.

In this message, Our Lady calls us to the power of the Holy Spirit. The first disciples found themselves on Pentecost. They were transformed. They had abandoned their teacher, their Lord. They were lost after Jesus was crucified. They were scared! Their Master had ascended into Heaven, and they were alone, scared and lost. On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit filled them with fire power. They became brave and committed witnesses and their future was clear. Their eyes were opened. They were lost; now they are found.

What can we do to help those who are lost today? We can become prayer warriors. We can assemble in Marian Cenacles. We can fast and do penances for sinners. We can prepare the lost souls for a new Pentecost. We can beg God for the grace that will open the eyes and hearts of the blind and lost. We must pray and nourish ourselves in the Sacraments so that we can be the light of Jesus in the darkened world. We, Our Lady's children, need to be that shining light of hope and love and joy. We first must pray for the fullness of the Holy Spirit; for we can do nothing on our own. Only then will we have hope for a better future and become witnesses of God's mercy in the world.

Saint Faustina, you told us that your mission would continue after your death and that you would not forget us. Relying on this, we ask your intercession for the graces we need to trust in Jesus as you did and thus to glorify His mercy every moment of our lives as our Blessed Mother has asked us – to be “joyful witnesses of God's mercy”. Amen
