February 25, 2015 Message

Despite the horrific atrocities playing out all over the world as well as the unprecedented bizarre weather patterns occurring all over, Our Lady comes to remind us that we are still living in a "time of grace". Most of us still enjoy the religious freedom to practice our Catholic Faith and receive daily the precious Body of Christ and enjoy the renewal of His friendship when we fall through the amazing Sacrament of Reconciliation. Our Lady has been talking to us for over 30 years of grace through Her apparitions in Medjugorje—guiding, mothering, loving and praying with us. Have we become too comfortable, too confident in Her presence?

Our Mother comes this month to remind us that she is praying WITH us. She expects that we are utilizing

every moment of this "time of grace" to also pray. Of course, we are praying! But notice that Mary tells us to pray more than we speak. Being very much aware of our modern day culture and the technology that most certainly has become a false god, She sees that we are "speaking" more than we are praying. We are glued to our smart phones, we text, we tweet, we talk on facebook, Instagram and every other device known to modern man! These often supercede God's dynamic spiritual technology – Prayer!

In comparison, how much of our precious gift of time do we spend talking to the awesome God of the universe who longs for our time and our communication? This a time we can look forward to each day to express our love and thankfulness to our Heavenly Father for His calling and grace. It is during this special time that we come to our loving spiritual Father to talk about our needs, hopes, fears and concerns for others.

Are we people of God who are sincere, trusting and open with God?

Do we recognize the power of God to miraculously intervene in our time of need?

Are we having genuine conversations with God, not recitations of memorized wish lists?

"All these devoted themselves with one accord to prayer, together with some women, and Mary the

mother of Jesus and his brothers" (Acts 1:14)

Our ancestors in faith had a vibrant prayer life and were obviously close to God. Some of these people were the same ones who had earlier asked Christ to teach them to pray! Through the power of prayer they developed an intimate relationship with God, and He often responded to their requests in miraculous ways.

"For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears turned to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against evildoers." (1Peter 3:12)

We have the ability to tap into God's dynamic spiritual technology; but our modern day technology interrupts the flow of God's power. God does not hear those who by choice are actively involved in sin. Sin creates a barrier between ourselves and God in which the working of His Spirit within us is diminished.

Our Lady addresses this barrier of sin between ourselves and God when she says "seek the will of God and live it according to the commandments" as does St. Paul in his letter to the Ephesians: "Therefore, putting away falsehood, speak the truth, each one to his neighbor, for we are members one of another. Be angry but do not sin; do not let the sun set on your anger, and do not leave room for the devil. The thief must no longer steal, but rather labor, doing honest work with his own hands, so that he may have something to share with one in need. No foul language should come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for needed edification, that it may impart grace to those who hear. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with which you were sealed for the day of redemption. All bitterness, fury, anger, shouting, and reviling must be removed from you, along with all malice. And be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven you in Christ." (Ephesians 4:25-32)

Simple as Our Lady's message of February 25th 2015 seems, She is calling us to become Saints with a capital "S". The days remaining in Lent would be a golden opportunity to practice praying more and speaking less. Fasting from our favorite use of technology would be pleasing to God.....and our Mother will be praying with us.....and for us.
