Our Lady of Medjugorje's Message Given to Marija Pavlovic-Lunett February 25, 2014

"Dear children! You see, hear and feel that in the hearts of many people there is no God. They do not want Him, because they are far from prayer and do not have peace. You, little children, pray - live God's commandments. You be prayer, you who from the very beginning said 'yes' to my call. Witness God and my presence and do not forget, little children: I am with you and I love you. From day to day I present you all to my Son Jesus. Thank you for having responded to my call."

Commentary on the February 25, 2014 Message

"I am sending you as sheep among wolves. So be wise as serpents and innocent as doves". (Matthew 10:16)

We see that in the hearts of many people there is no God! We see images of global uprisings – almost daily now on the world news channels. We see heart wrenching images of brutality – beatings, shootings, animal abuse. We see images of promiscuity on the big screen.

We hear the sound of the silent screams of the

innocent victims of abortion and child abuse. We hear the profanity of rage – road rage and anger. We hear the bickering in families: brother against brother, daughter against mother, etc. We hear lies perpetrated by the father of lies.

We feel the corruption that comes from power in government. We feel the hopelessness and the desperation of a world without God. We feel the shallowness of the human person focused solely on the superficial.

Our Lady comes to tell us, "You see, hear and feel that in hearts of many people there is no God". She sees these Godless hearts as well. But Mary sees so much more. She sees souls falling like leaves off a tree into hell. She sees the legions of demons prowling the earth seeking the ruin of souls. She sees the damnation of those hearts who die in their selfishness. She hears their cries and feels their pains – eternally!

The people that Our Lady is referring to are cut off from their Source. They have no life line to God. They do not pray. They do not acknowledge God as the source of all that exists. They do not recognize the Eucharist as Jesus' great promise to remain with us always – even to the end of time. They do not talk to God because, for them, there is no God. Hearts that do not know God are empty hearts. They are hearts filled with junk

– the stuff of life that corrodes, vanishes like the grass. These are the hearts that are filled with illusions and sustained by that which comes to a sudden and abrupt end. They do not know peace. They do not know the Prince of Peace.

Our Lady calls us this month to be the light in their darkness. We, who pray and live God's commandments; especially the commandment to love are lights. We are like a lamp set upon a mountain top. We are called to shine with the truths of the Gospel. Our Mother asks us to "be prayer". We are asked to be the communicator of God's Word. Our Lady has heard our "yes" to her call. We are called to "always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks us for a reason for our hope". (1Peter 3:15)


