January 25, 2015

"Dear children! Also today I call you: live your vocation in prayer. Now, as never before, Satan wants to suffocate man and his soul by his contagious wind of hatred and unrest. In many hearts there is no joy because there is no God or prayer. Hatred and war are growing from day to day. I am calling you, little children, begin anew, with enthusiasm, the walk of holiness and love; since I have come among you because of this. Together let us be love and forgiveness for all those who know and want to love only with a human love and not with that immeasurable love of God to which God calls you. Little children, may hope in a better tomorrow always be in your heart. Thank you for having responded to my call."

Commentary on the January 25, 2015 Message

"Live your vocation in prayer"..... Sounds simple, doesn't it? To live our vocation in the midst of a world whose values are often far from God is NOT simple, in fact. To remain true and obedient to Gospel values when those values are counter-cultural is anything but simple. Our Lady listens to the nightly News Stations. She sees with great clarity Satan's hindrances confronting us

at every turn in living our vocations in prayer. Mary knows the obstacles that Satan places along our path to discourage us from prayer. Our Heavenly Mother knows that without prayer we are on our vocational paths without directions, without light. Without prayer, we are lost in the woods of this fallen world.

"Live your vocation in prayer"..... In every message, Our Lady exhorts us to pray! Sounds easy, doesn't it? We know how to pray. When Jesus taught his disciples how to pray, He began, "Our Father, who art in Heaven....." He gave us the foundational prayer: 'The Lord's prayer'. We pray it often. He also told us to go off alone – someplace where only the Father can hear us....and pray – speak to our Father in Heaven. We know how to pray. We use the formula: A C T S: we ask for what we need. We tell God we are sorry for our sins and failings – we are contrite. We thank God for our many blessings. We pray for our world and those we hold dear. We are people of prayer. But do we pray constantly? Are we disciplined in the time we spend with God? Are the fruits of prayer evident in our daily lives? Do we buckle under the pressure of adversity? Do we trust in God's providential plan for our lives? Are we still fearful of what we will confront along the path? We still have work to do! Prayer and faithfulness – not so easy, is it?

“Live your vocation in prayer”Why? Because Satan wants to suffocate us! In other words, Satan wants to kill us by blocking our airways to God. He wants to stifle and smother our prayer with worries, distractions, negativity and hatred. Negativity, hatred and unrest are contagious. They are passed on from one person to another through contact just like the virus. Poisonous influences are passed on from one mind to the next. The mind is the devil’s battlefield.

Our Lady often reminds us that there is no joy among us. The world tries to sell us a bill of goods that counterfeits for joy and happiness. We often take the bait of money, power, fame, materialism. The world will never offer us God or prayer. Therefore, the world will never be able to deliver joy to our hearts. Hatred and war grows in hearts by the day. We are in spiritual, physical and mental turmoil. God’s Divine Providence allows Mary to enter our battlefield as our General to guide and lead us through the minefield. We must adhere to Her messages in this decisive time. There is suffering all around us. We are all too often living in dreaded fear of the next shoe to drop. As we proceed through the dense fog of faith, there is a light. Mary holds the Light so that our feet do not stumble.

There is a greater love than the human love to which we are constantly trying to cling. It is the immeasurable love of God. It calls us to be love; that is, to sacrifice our very selves for the good of humanity. It calls us to take the high road of forgiveness when we feel fully justified to hold a grudge or to judge.

We are called to be the Good News in the midst of the bad. We are called to be the light in the darkness of sin, evil and doubt. We are called to bear the Spirit of Jesus Christ to a world in desperate need of salvation. We must never allow Satan to suffocate our spirits or smother our hope for a better tomorrow. We must follow Mary, our Mother, our General, our Love. With her, hope will live eternal with us and its’ embers light up our world.

St. Paul tells the Romans: “I want you to be wise as to what is good, and simple as to what is evil: then the God of peace will quickly crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.”(Romans 16:19)
